

**Blue (excluding Teal and Aqua), Black, Gray or Khaki Pants or Walking Shorts - All Clothing is Solid Color**

1. Jeans, exercise apparel, (sweatpants, yoga pants, nylon pants, etc.) and jeggings are NOT permitted.
2. Shorts must be respectable and modest in length.  
(*Modest in length is defined as the width of the student's hand from the bottom of the article of clothing to the top of their bended knee*)
3. A belt must be worn if pants or shorts have belt loops- Offensive or inappropriate belt buckles, as determined by the administration, are NOT permitted.
4. Clothing items must be worn at the natural waist.

**White, Blue (excluding Teal and Aqua), Black or Gray Shirts or Blouses - All Clothing is Solid Color**

1. All shirts and blouses must have a collar and must be tucked in.
2. Only top button can be unbuttoned. NO cleavage shall be visible.
3. Turtlenecks, mock and regular, polo shirts, and button-down shirts are permitted.
4. Sleeveless shirts or t-shirts are NOT permitted.
5. Undergarments, camisoles and undershirts, of school colors, can ONLY be worn UNDER a collared shirt. (NOT over top the collared shirt). Ties are acceptable, but not mandatory.
6. No skin should be visible between the waistband of the pants and the bottom of the shirt.
7. All logos shall be no larger than the size of the student's closed fist.

**Blue (excluding Teal and Aqua), Black, Gray or Khaki, Skorts Skirts, Jumpers or Dresses - All Clothing is Solid Color**

1. Skorts, skirts, jumpers or dresses must be respectable and modest in length.  
(*Modest in length is defined as the width of the student's hand from the bottom of the article of clothing to the top of their bended knee*)
2. Skorts, skirts and jumpers must be accompanied by a uniform approved shirt.

**White, Blue (excluding Teal and Aqua), Black or Gray Crewneck, V-Neck, Cardigan Style Sweaters or Crewneck Style Sweatshirts - All**

Clothing is Solid Color

1. Only long sleeve solid blue, white, black or gray crewneck, v-neck or cardigan sweaters, fleece, or crewneck sweatshirts can be worn with a white, blue, black or gray collared shirt, turtleneck, ½ zip pullover or blouse.
2. All sweaters and sweatshirts do not need to be tucked in; all other shirts must be tucked in.
3. Hooded apparel is not permitted.

**Woodbridge School District student organizations and competition jersey attire.**

1. Approved as acceptable uniform on competition day ONLY; no hooded attire permitted.
2. A uniform approved shirt must be worn under the jersey.

**Appropriate physical education attire is determined by the physical education teacher.**

1. Cut-offs, frayed seams and holes are not permitted on any clothing.

**Footwear**

1. Footwear in any color is acceptable; however, no open heel permitted.
2. Clogs without straps, flip-flops, and bedroom slippers are NOT permitted.
3. Footwear must be securely fastened.

**Jackets and Coats**

1. Jackets and coats are NOT permitted to be worn in the building.

**Accessories**

1. Hats, head coverings, visors, bandanas, combs/picks and sunglasses may not be worn in the building.
2. Any offensive or inappropriate accessory as determined by administration is not permitted. This includes but is not limited to emblems and socks.

**Procurement**

1. Procurement may come from multiple vendors who meet the basic requirements as stated above.
2. Clothing must be sized to fit the student.
