**5. PRESENTATIONS /RECOGNITIONS**

A. Woodbridge Middle School - School Improvement Team

- The WMS SIT consists of Mrs. Morroni, Ms. Moyer, Mrs. Madden, Mrs. Batchelor, Mrs. Bollinger, Ms. Jacobson, Mrs. Lewandowski, Mrs. Thornton, Mrs. Polite, Mrs. Schofer, Mr. Lewis, Ms. O’Neal.

- Initial planning meetings were held in July and August of 2015. The data analyzed included attendance, discipline, report card, SBAC/DCAS, School Climate, Promotion/Retention, Walk-throughs, time audit, student health needs, demographics, and extracurricular activities.
- The approval process consisted of the 1<sup>st</sup> submission in mid-January, 2<sup>nd</sup> submission in March, and the 3<sup>rd</sup> and final submission in March with approval received on April 8<sup>th</sup>.
- Theory of Action is to build a positive school culture, improve Tier 1 instruction, and provide ample opportunities for remediation.
- Goal 1: To build a positive school culture with outcomes to include continued participation in the School Climate Survey, Professional Development on Understanding the Framework of Poverty and Research-Based Instructional Strategies, a staggered start for the 6<sup>th</sup> grade, revision of Advisor/Advisee program, building PBS expectations, and the continued implementation of the Compassionate Schools model.
- Goal 2: Improve Tier 1 Instruction with outcomes to include forming a scheduling committee to review and recommend changes to the master schedule to Administration; complete another Time Audit, professional development on Differentiated Instruction, Provide coaching through the implementation phases of differentiation and student engagement, development and distribution of post Professional Development expectations by Administration, and the continuation of PLC's by content areas.
- Goal 3: Provide Ample Opportunities for Remediation with outcomes to include strengthening the RTI program, developing Learning Maps for RTI, increasing teacher capacity to analyze student data, provide extended learning opportunities for students, the continuation of "One School, One Book" Literacy Program, and the development and implementation of a peer Walk-through format.

B. WHS Construction Project – Mr. Chasanov

- Worth and Nickel are working to complete their punch list items to be ready for final payout within the next few weeks.
- The pole building is moving along quickly. Overhead doors are installed, electric is roughed in, and an additional service door was installed per the Fire Marshal's request. We are waiting on the Fire Marshal's approval of plan revisions submitted on April 25.
- Once Delaware Electric Co-op runs the electric to the building, Pioneer has minimal construction duties remaining to make the building complete and ready for final inspection.

C. 2016 Teacher Recruitment Update – Mr. Cameron

- Eight recruiting fairs were attended by various administrators this spring.
- We have 21 positions open; 19 teachers/specialists and 2 administrators. After tonight's meeting and pending your approval this number will be down to 5.
- All of the recruiting fairs have been down this year, with the exception of the PERC job fair outside of Pittsburgh.
- University of Delaware hosts Project Search each year and they reported the candidate pool was down 25% this year.
- The Greater Philadelphia Teacher Recruitment event is down 1000 candidates over the past 2 years.
- Many personnel directors are concerned about a teacher shortage due to many people not going into the teaching profession.
- The early retirement incentive from the early 90's is hitting the 25 year mark this year.

- A. Board of Education Election Results – Mr. Chasanov
- Mr. Chasanov and Mr. Breeding congratulated Mr. Barr on his re-election as Board Member.
  - Mrs. Alberta Smith was thanked for caring about the students and running a good campaign.
- B. April 2016 Budgetary Report – Mr. Chasanov
- Tax collection is at 102.45% of expected collection
  - Cost Center shows that with 83.5% of the year past 80.5% of the budget is spent with salaries at 78.3%
  - Line 16 – Utility line – we will be going over due to the state financial system being shut down in June. June 2015 utility bill was paid in July 2016.
  - All accounts are in good standing.

- A. Phillis Wheatley Elementary School – Dr. Leach
- Mr. Zedalis did a great job with our spring concert! Our 5<sup>th</sup> grade band performed very well. We had great parent turnout.
  - We are excited with our School Climate Survey results. The goal is 100 points. With 533 students taking the survey we scored 99.6 points. 44 teachers scored 101 points. We had 195 families take the survey with the score of 98 points.
  - The fifth grade is going to the Baltimore Aquarium on May 26.
  - Our Field Day dates are as follows: 3<sup>rd</sup> grade – June 1<sup>st</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> grade – June 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup> grade – June 7<sup>th</sup>.
